

SAPS ABUSE OF JUSTICE

(Failure to prosecute Czarek Rybak, and unlawful arrest of Lloyd Thomas)

Bothasig and Parow: 2012 to 2014.

1. Mrs Virginia Stoianov **Physical Assault** by Czarek Rybak at Edgemead Shopping Centre (31 October 2012)
Bothasig Case **187/10/2012** (under maiden surname of 'Nico')
(Goodwood: 'Struck off Roll', Remand D 2012-11-23 B2454/2012
on the false ground of it being a 'debt dispute'. Victim not informed)
2. Rev. Lloyd Thomas **Attempted Assault** by Czarek Rybak, Welgelegen (31 October 2012)
(prevented by showing gas-pistol, which assailant then tries to wrest from grasp of victim)
Parow Case **419/11/2012** (witnesses: Ivo Stoianov and Valentino Petkov).
3. Rev. Lloyd Thomas **Attempted arrest and hand-cuffing** in Edgemead Shopping Centre (1 November 2012), on false charge by Czarek Rybak of 'pointing a firearm' (SAP 14/13/11/2012).
4. Rev. Lloyd Thomas **Arrest and detention** at Parow police station on the above charge; gas-pistol seized by SAPS for 'ballistic testing' (1 November 2012).
5. Rev. Lloyd Thomas **My home searched** for firearms (without warrant, 2 November 2012).
6. Rev. Lloyd Thomas **August 2013**: Det.Const. Davids (Bothasig) informs me at Goodwood Court that the assault-case warrant **cannot be served** on Czarek Rybak as he is **unable to be traced**.
(I provide his residential and business details to Bothasig Detectives. No response).
7. Rev Lloyd Thomas **complaint to Independent Police Investigative Directorate (IPID)**
12 September 2013.
8. SAPS Branch Commander, Parow, phones me 6 March 2014 to say case against me now dropped, and my gas-pistol may be collected **7 March 2014.**

NO RESPONSE from IPID as at 8 July 2014
